CASTING DIRECTOR RANDI RIEDIGER'S ADR/DUBBING WORKSHOP



If you've watched foreign-made animation like **INUYASHA**, **POKEMON**, **DIGIMON**, or **NARUTO**, you might wonder how they do the English language voices for the shows. The process is called **DUBBING** or **ADR**.

Automated Dialogue Replacement or **Additional Dialogue Recording** is the process of re-recording the dialogue. The voices of the original actors are substituted by different performers, often in a different language.



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

How to watch the picture on the screen, read a script, act, and sustain a character all at the same time!

You will do this in a studio setting, using the same equipment as professional ADR actors.

You will also learn the art of **WALLA**, making background crowd noises, which are used in all types of video entertainment.

It's one thing to build a character and a voice, but being able to do ADR is a skill that will prove very valuable.
